

Suggested House White Wines & Champagnes

- Bin
- 28 **Champagne Royer Grand Cuvée NV**
A crisp, well balanced champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche yeastiness. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.
- 3 **Terre Allege, Veneto, Italy 2006/07**
Trebiano
Light and refreshing, with aromas of citrus and lemony fruits, but with an appealing underlying fl character. On the palate the wine is full of pineapple flavours complimenting the citrus fruits.
- 2 **Terra Decica, Cramele Recasi**
Pinot Grigio
Pale straw yellow in colour with a bright and flowery fragrance. Light, crisp and dry with a racy acidity that gives mouth-watering appeal.
- 4 **Nostros Reserva, Chile, 2007/08**
Sauvignon Blanc
This is a stylish, complex Sauvignon with intense, grassy, tropical notes on the nose followed by a rich palate of crisp, tangy fruit. Full flavoured and very long, this is a classic example of why the best Chilean Sauvignon is so sought after.
- 12 **Los Espinos, Chile**
Chardonnay
Crisp clean tropical fruit flavours of melon and pineapple on the nose and palate, with underlying vanilla wood tones. Medium-full bodied style, with a long lingering length.
- 16 **Les Acrobates, Vin de Pays Tolosan, Languedoc France 2006/07**
Ugni blanc/Grenache blanc.
Bursting with fruit, this has greengages on the nose combined with quite complex mixed floral notes. In the mouth it has zingy acidity and plenty of ripe green fruits and citrus character. Well-balanced, refreshing and lively. Surprisingly long length finishes this very appealing wine.

Suggested House Red Wines & Rosé

- 34 **Terre Allege, Veneto, Italy 2006/07**
Sangiovese
A soft but structured wine, with lively raspberry, stonefruit and plum flavours all underpinned by wonderful Italian cherry earthiness. The concentrated fruit flavours are balanced by clean acidity supple tannins.
- 47 **Fernandez de Manzanos, Rioja, 2007/08**
Tempranillo
Aromas of red berries, fresh strawberry leaf and some hints of spice. Rounded and soft, medium bodied showing crunchy red berry and hedgerow fruit.
- 45 **Los Espinos, Rapel Valley, Chile, 2007/08**
Merlot
Soft and appealing on the nose, with flavours of dark berry fruits and plum pudding. The wine is deliciously rich, ripe and fruity with lovely concentrated plum and red cherry fruit combining with the soft tannins and easy, balanced acidity to make this wine a real favourite.
- 39 **Les Acrobates Vin de Pays de L'Hérault, France 2006/07**
Grenache/Merlot
Soft and rich with tremendous flavours of wild strawberry and ripe red fruits, this wine shows the art of blending two of the region's most powerful grapes. The wine is cherry red in colour and has a high level of finesse and approachability, making it the perfect easy-drinking red.
- 50 **Reserve 'The Golden Duck', One Chain Vineyards, Australia 2005/06**
Shiraz
This wine blends rich, gutsy Barossa fruit with cooler, more cerebral Pyrenees Shiraz to make a delicious, richly flavoured but well structured red with heaps of creamy bramble fruit overlaid with spice and subtle vanillin oak.
- 24 **Finaca Lasierpe Rosando, Vino de la Tierra, Spain 2006/07**
Syrah **Rosé**
A vivid, bright pink with all the ripe, juicy fruit one would expect. Soft, well rounded and amazingly drinkable, this is the perfect accompaniment to long sunny days. Soft red fruits and an inherent spiciness give this wine all round appeal
